
Dear Story:

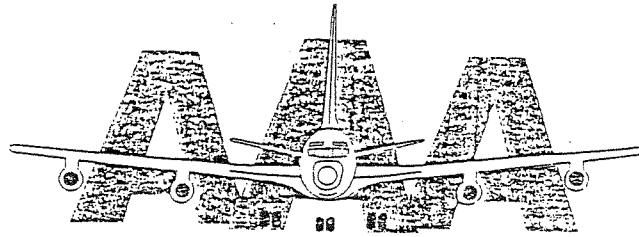
